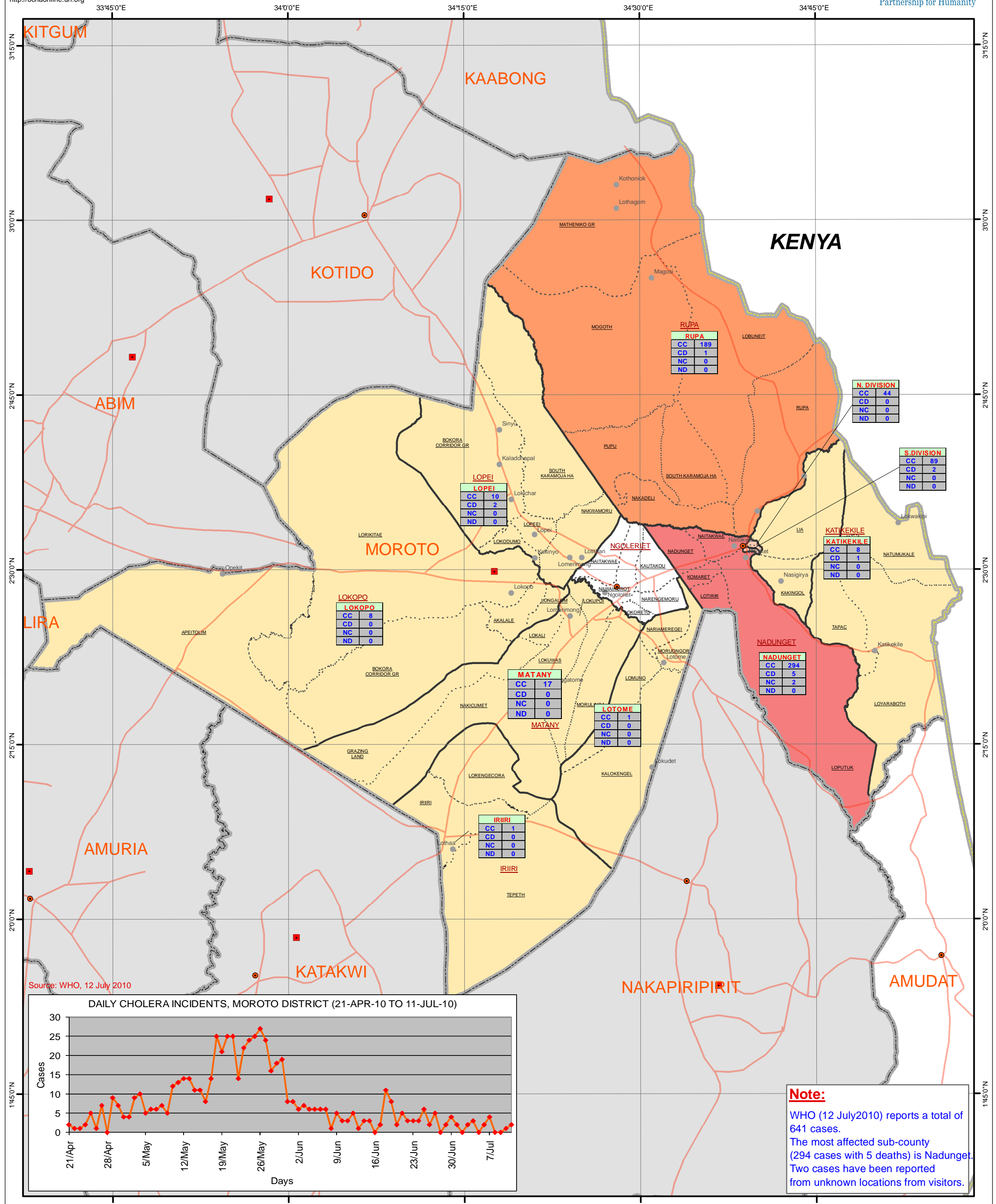
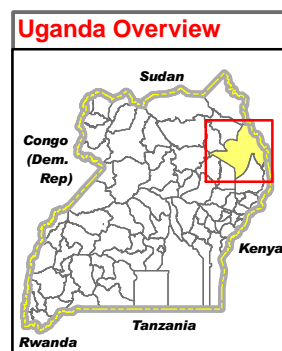


Moroto District: Cholera Affected Areas & Cases (as of 12 July 2010)
