 2. Mobilization of additional resources for the other outbreak response interventions including social mobilization and public information; case management and surveillance

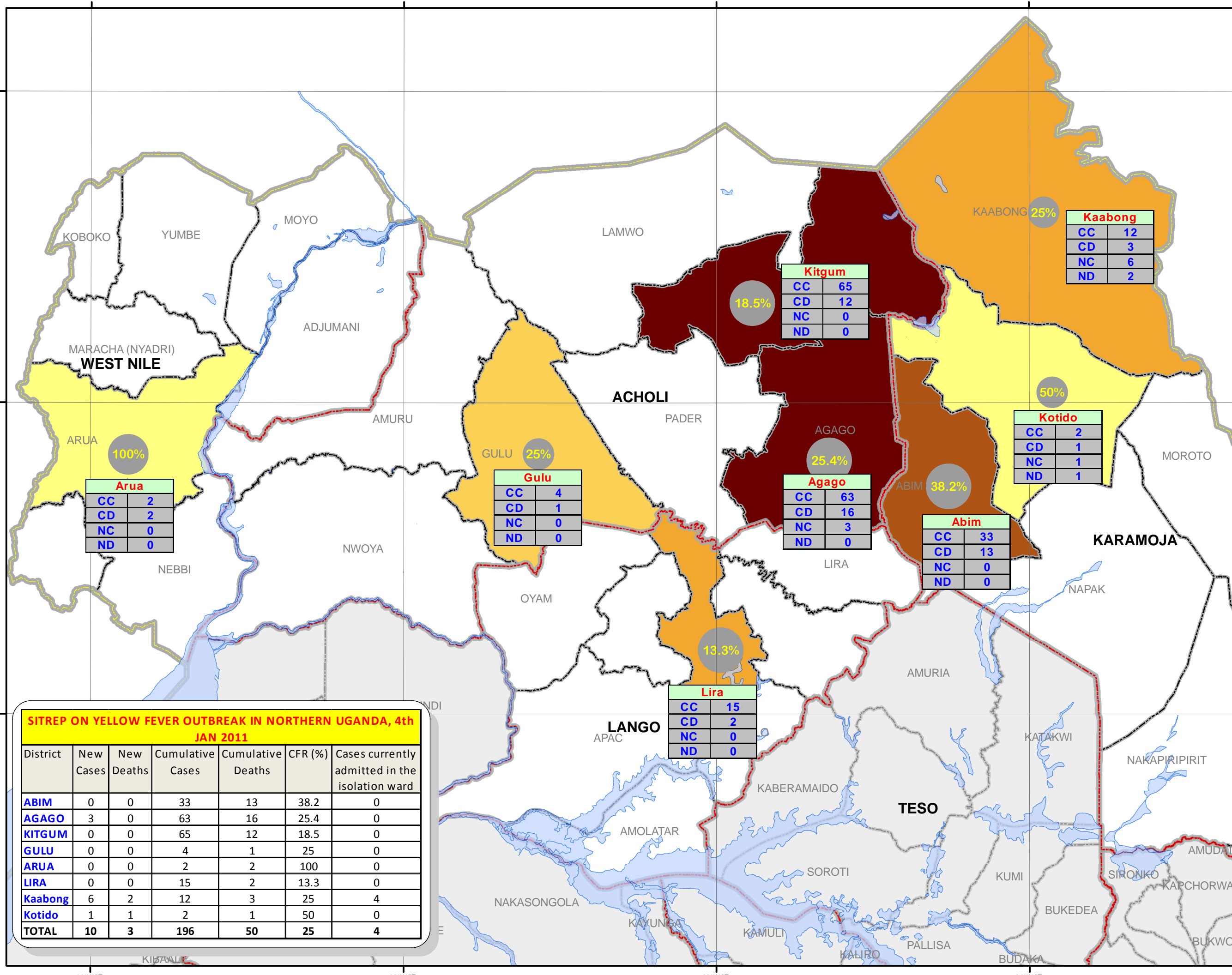
