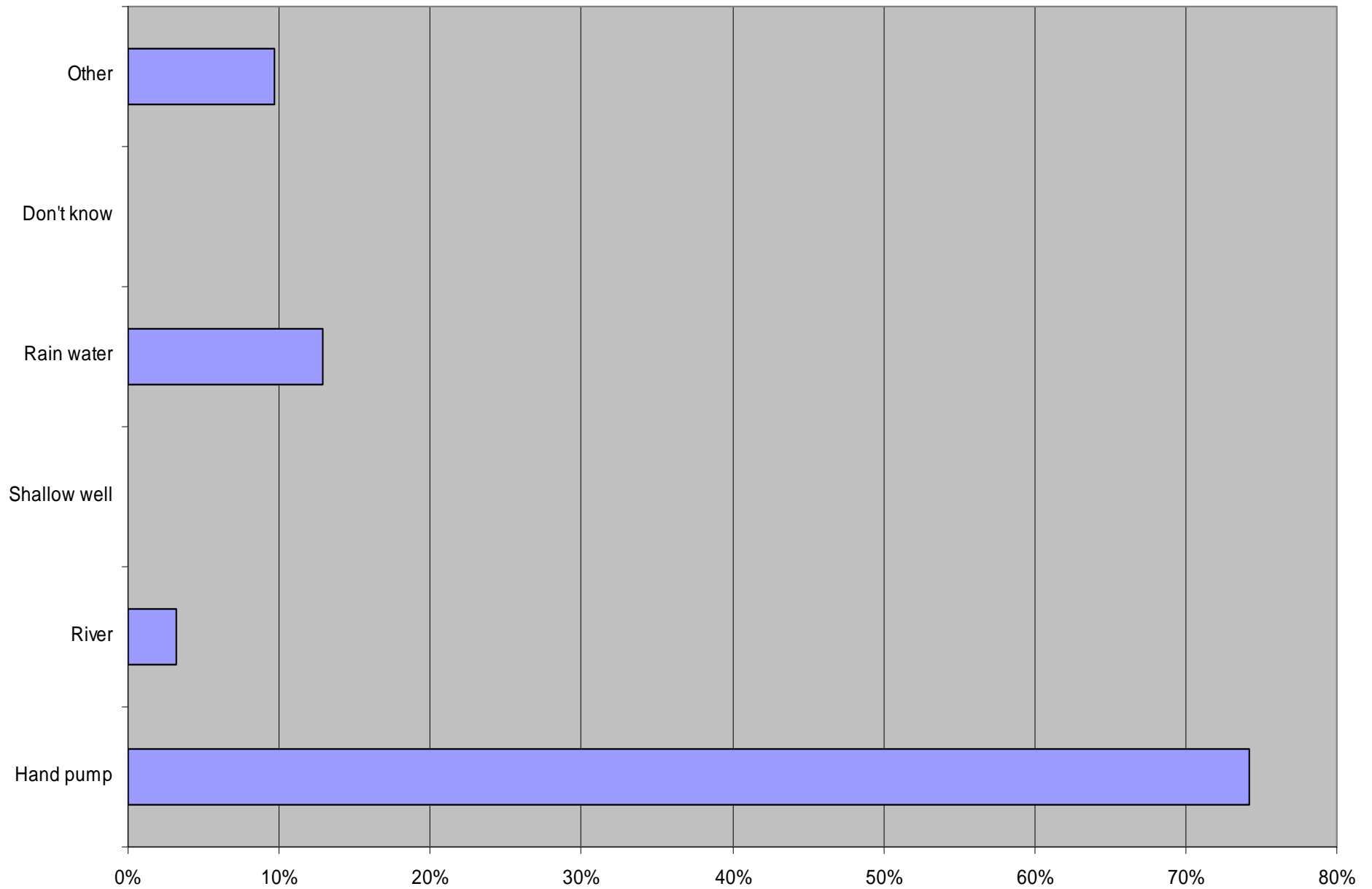
ACTED & WASH in Karamoja

Over the course of ACTED's intervention the organization has noted the following:

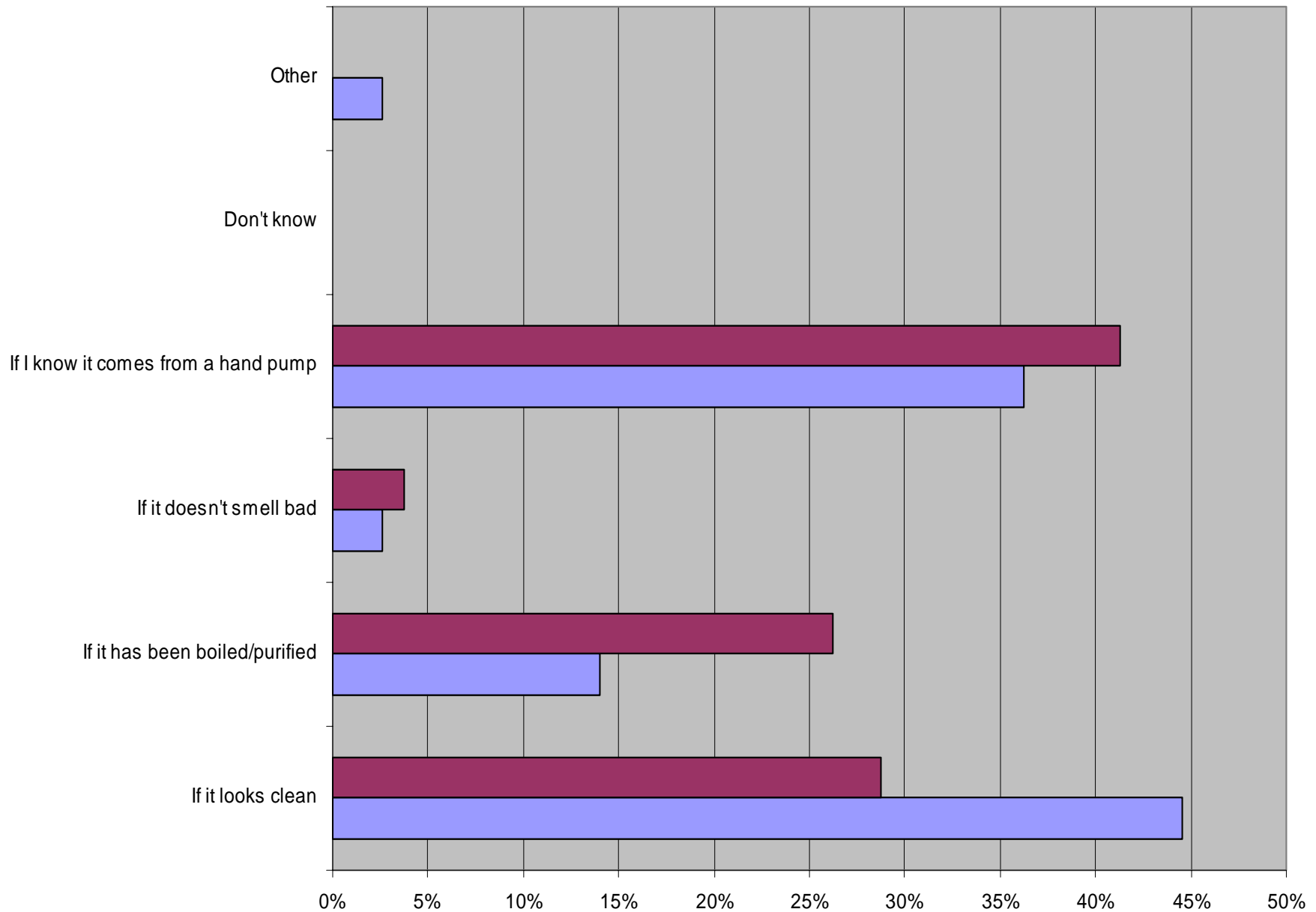
- A lack of boreholes and safe water sources (especially for schools)

- The following surveys are taken from ACTED's intervention schools and have an overall sample size of 150 students and 45 teachers.



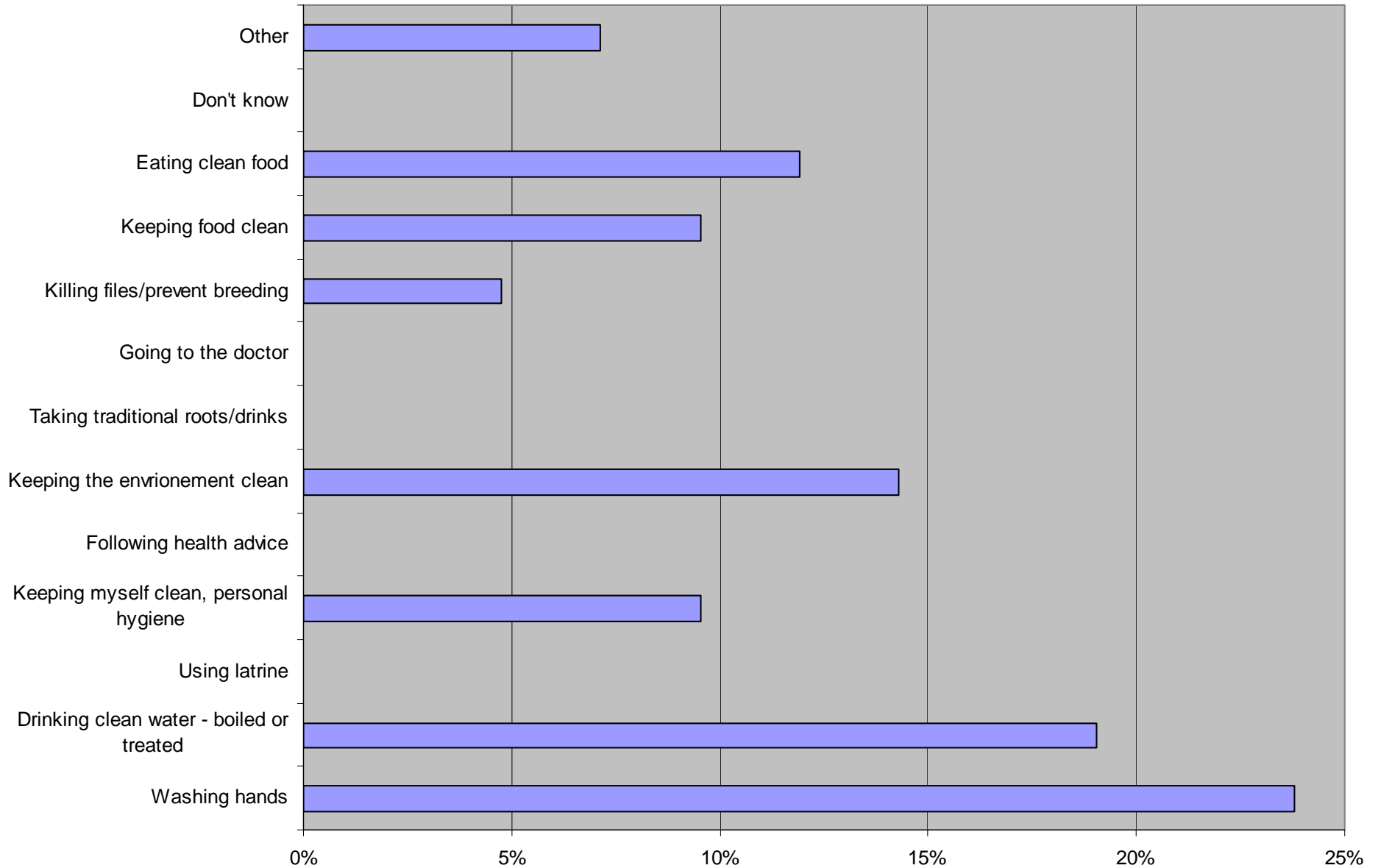
Teachers School Water Source?



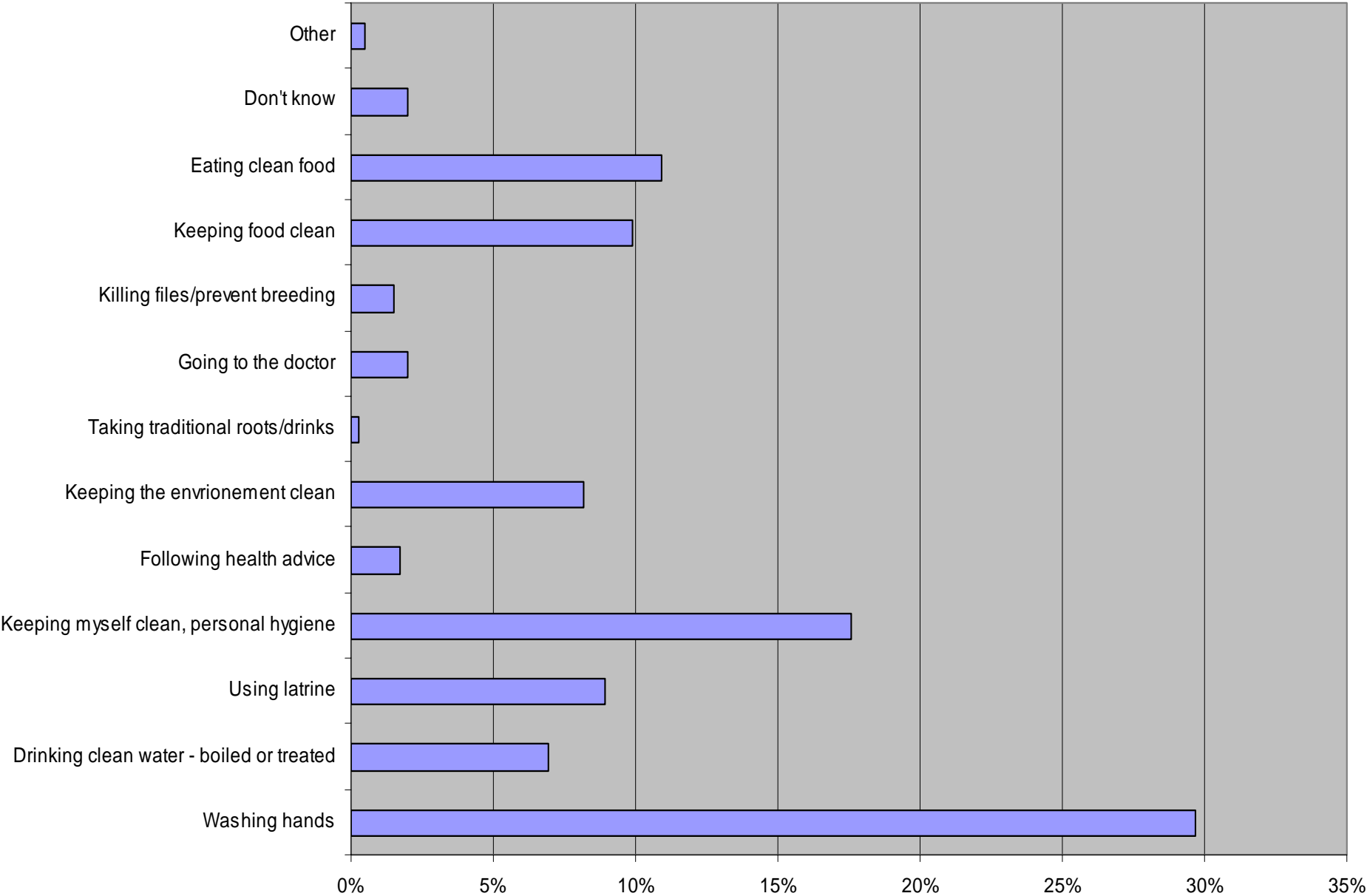
Students Knowledge of Safe Water Sources
