

GBV SUB COUNTY MINIMUM PACKAGE, 1.1

A Gender-based violence system is composed of three elements:

- 1) Structures (government, non-governmental and community-based)
- 2) Coordination mechanisms for referrals, reporting and monitoring;
- 3) Basic multi-sectoral service provision

At the sub-county level, a GBV system is composed at a minimum of:

- 1 designated ACDO
- 1 appointed GBV lead agency (NGO/CBO)
- 1 operational community based structure (be it a village health team, a child protection committee, youth/women's groups etc.)
- 1 health facility with post-rape care supplies in stock
- 2 health facility staff persons trained in post rape care & protocols
- 2 Child & Family Unit Police focal points

For a system to be functional the members of the GBV structures (ACDOs, village health teams, police, health staff) must have adequate training and the required capacities to handle GBV cases in full application of international and national protection and care standards.
