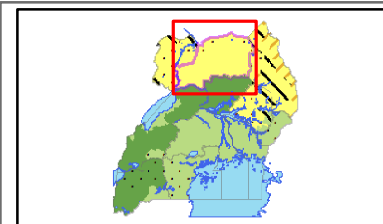

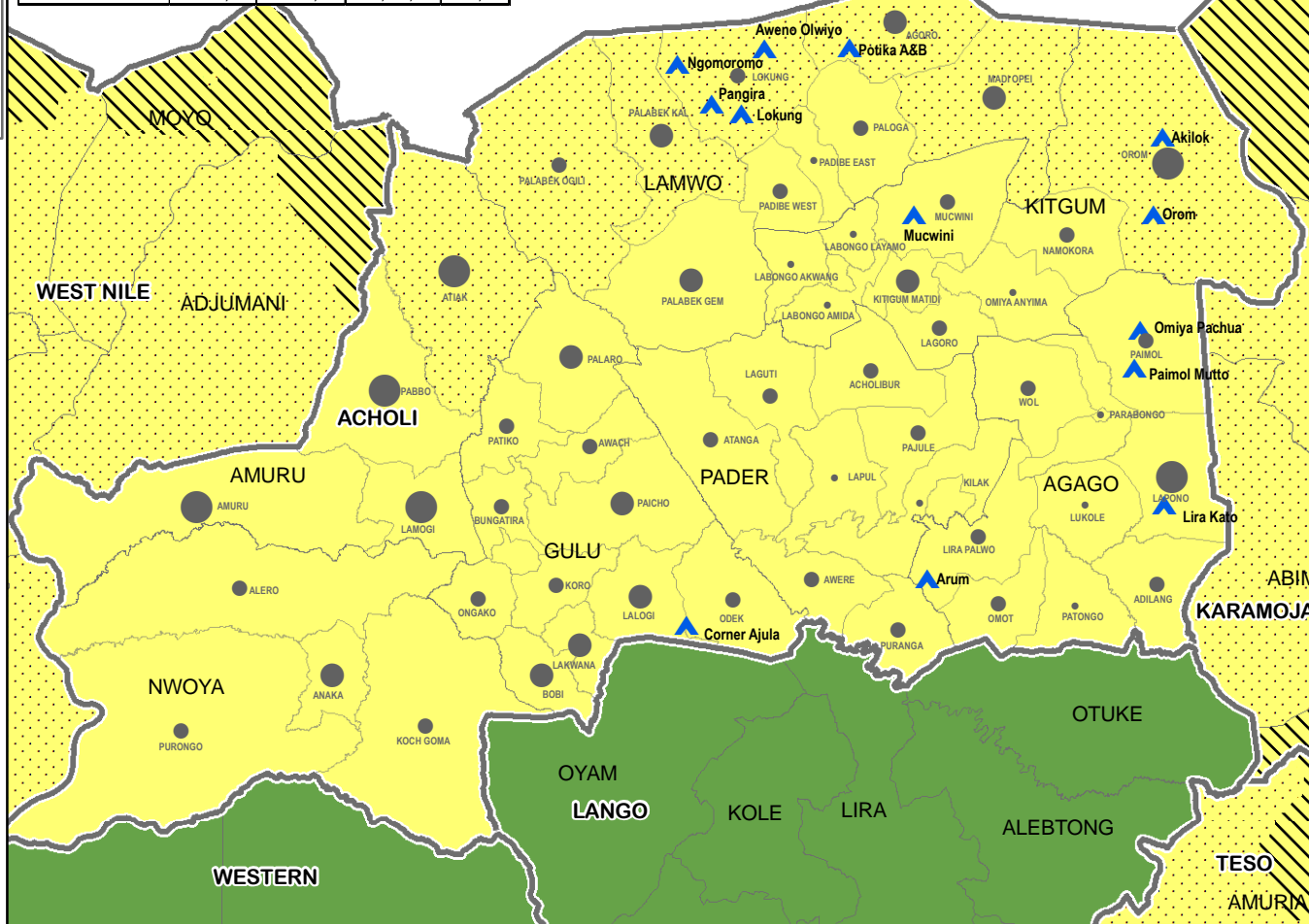

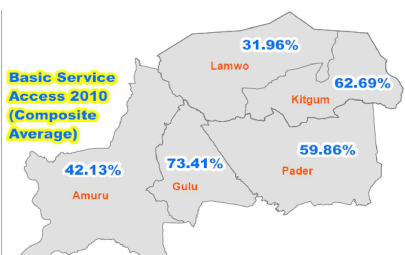

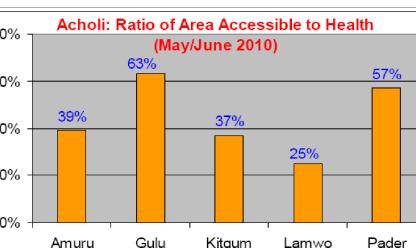

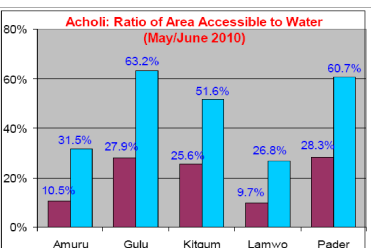

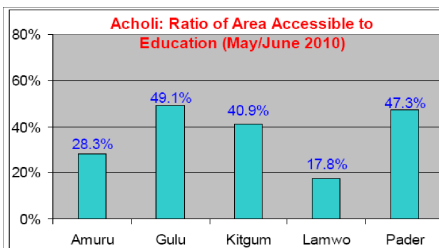
Ratio of district area access to Health Centres within 5 km distance



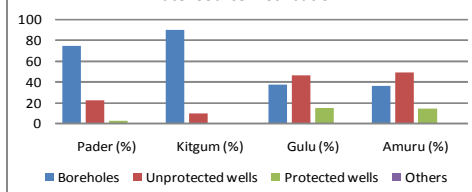
Ratio of district area access to Water Sources within 2 km distance
