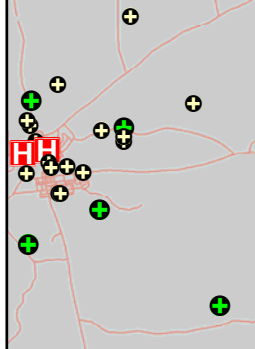

 - Accessibility is based on aerial distance. Assumed that people travel most direct route in plain area.
 - Pie size is graduated by total area of sub-County.
