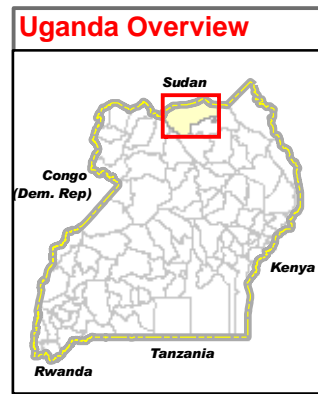
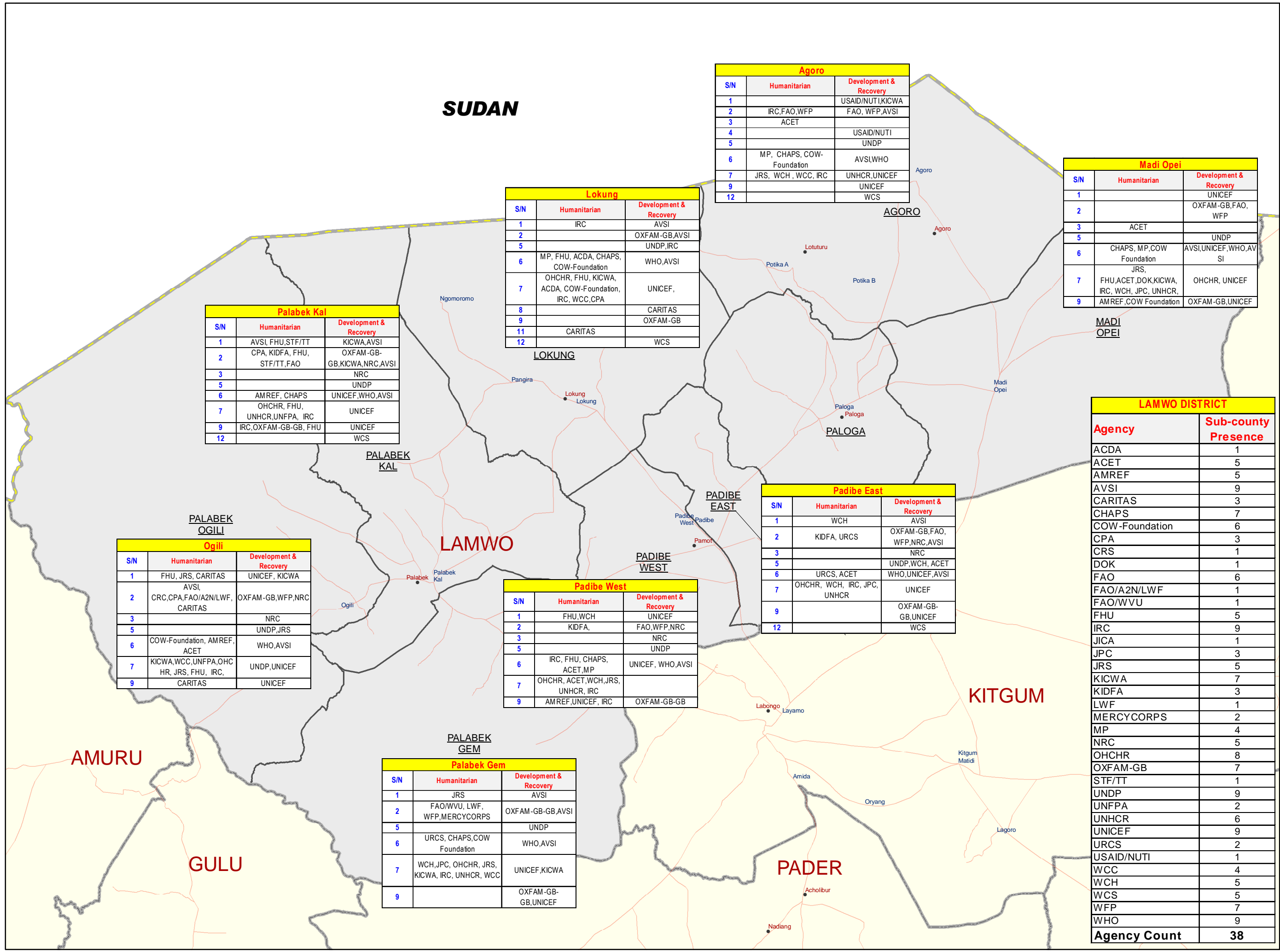


# Lamwo District: Humanitarian, Recovery and Development Organizations Presence by Sector per Sub-County (July 2010)
