

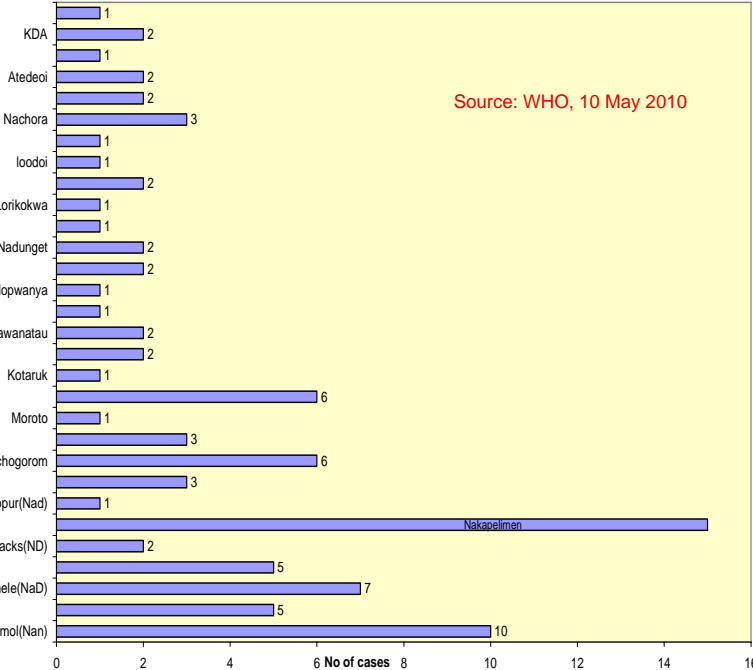

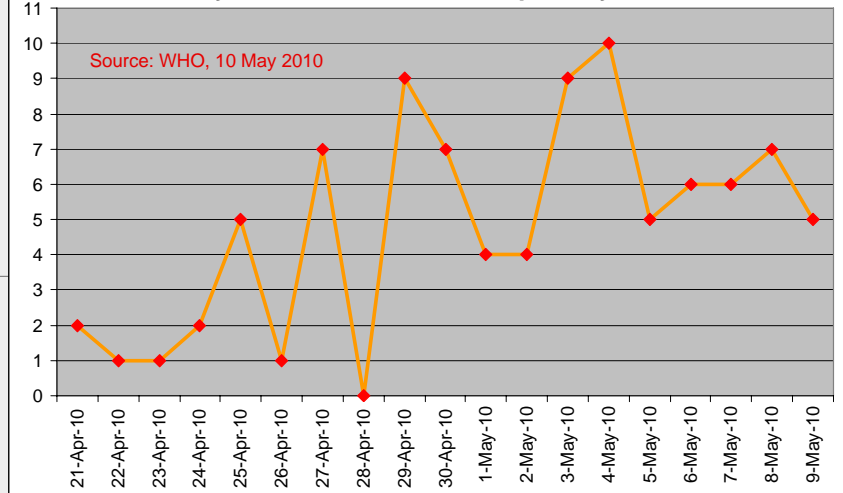
Distribution of Cases by Village, 10 May 2010
