 2. Mountainous areas (Singula, Kitikikile) - not easily accessible.  
 3. Areas with open markets (Matany, Iriiri, Kangole, Kosiro, Katanga, Nakiloro) and trading centers.  
 4. Villages along the down stream of the rivers and streams (Kanakomol, Nachelle, Lotome, Kambihinzi, etc.)  
 5. Areas around all health facilities and CTCs.
