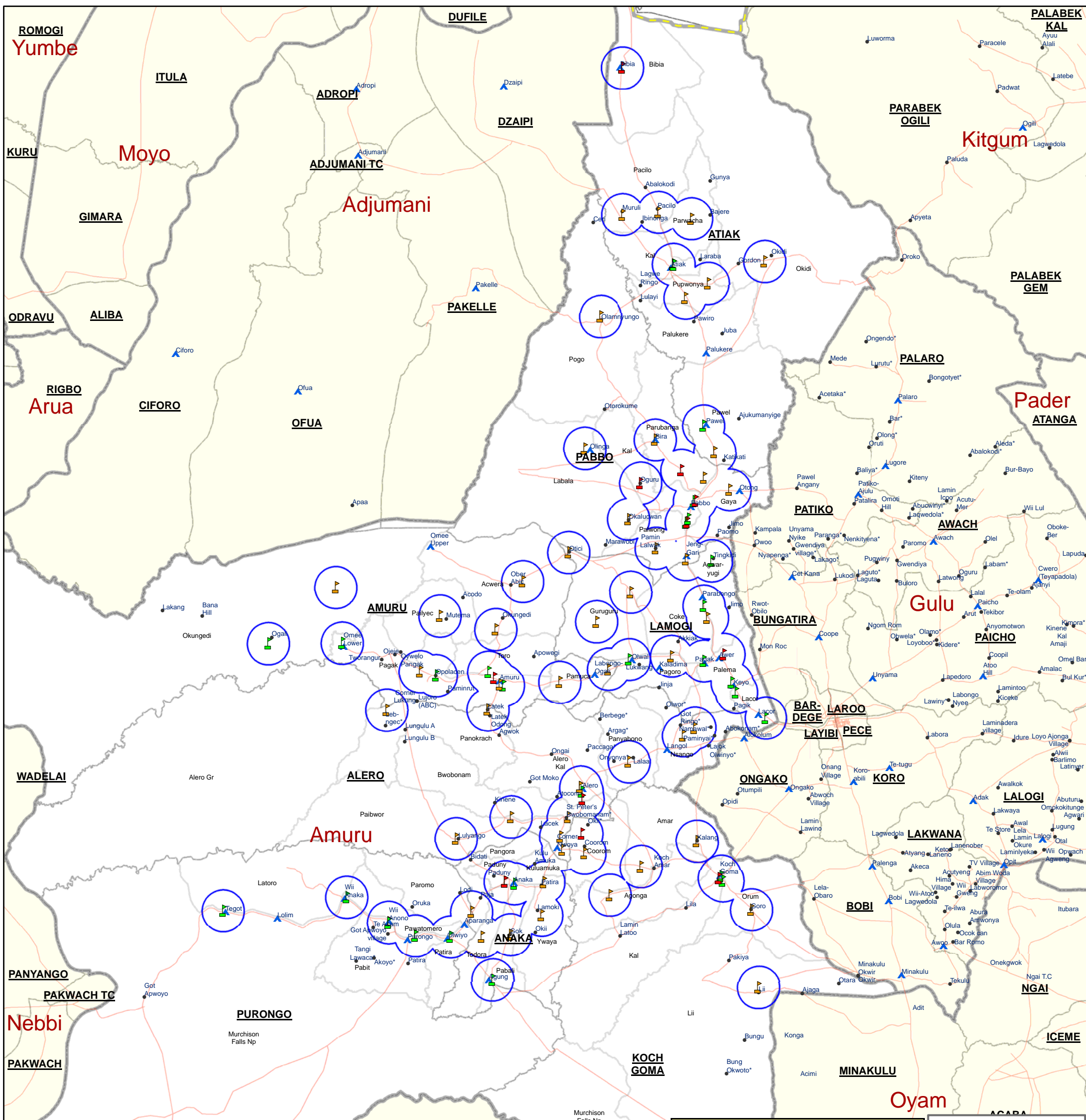

 2- Approx. area falls inside 2.5km accessibility zones are treated as accessible & falls outside are treated as inaccessible.  
 3- Accessibility is based on aerial distance. Assumed that pupils travel most direct route in plain area.
