Notes:

- Total number of parish touched by 2.5 km access buffers, and approximate ratio of access area within sub-County are derived by using GIS technique. 2.5 km radius circle is equivalent to 19.643 sq.km area (using formula $A = \pi * R^2$).
- Approximate area falls inside 2.5 km accessibility zones are treated as accessible & falls outside are treated as not accessible.
- Accessibility is based on aerial distance. Assumed that students travel most direct route in plain area.
- Pie size is graduated by total populated area of the sub-County.
