 - Accessibility is based on aerial distance. Assumed that students travel most direct route in plain area.
 - Pie size is graduated by total populated area of the sub-County.

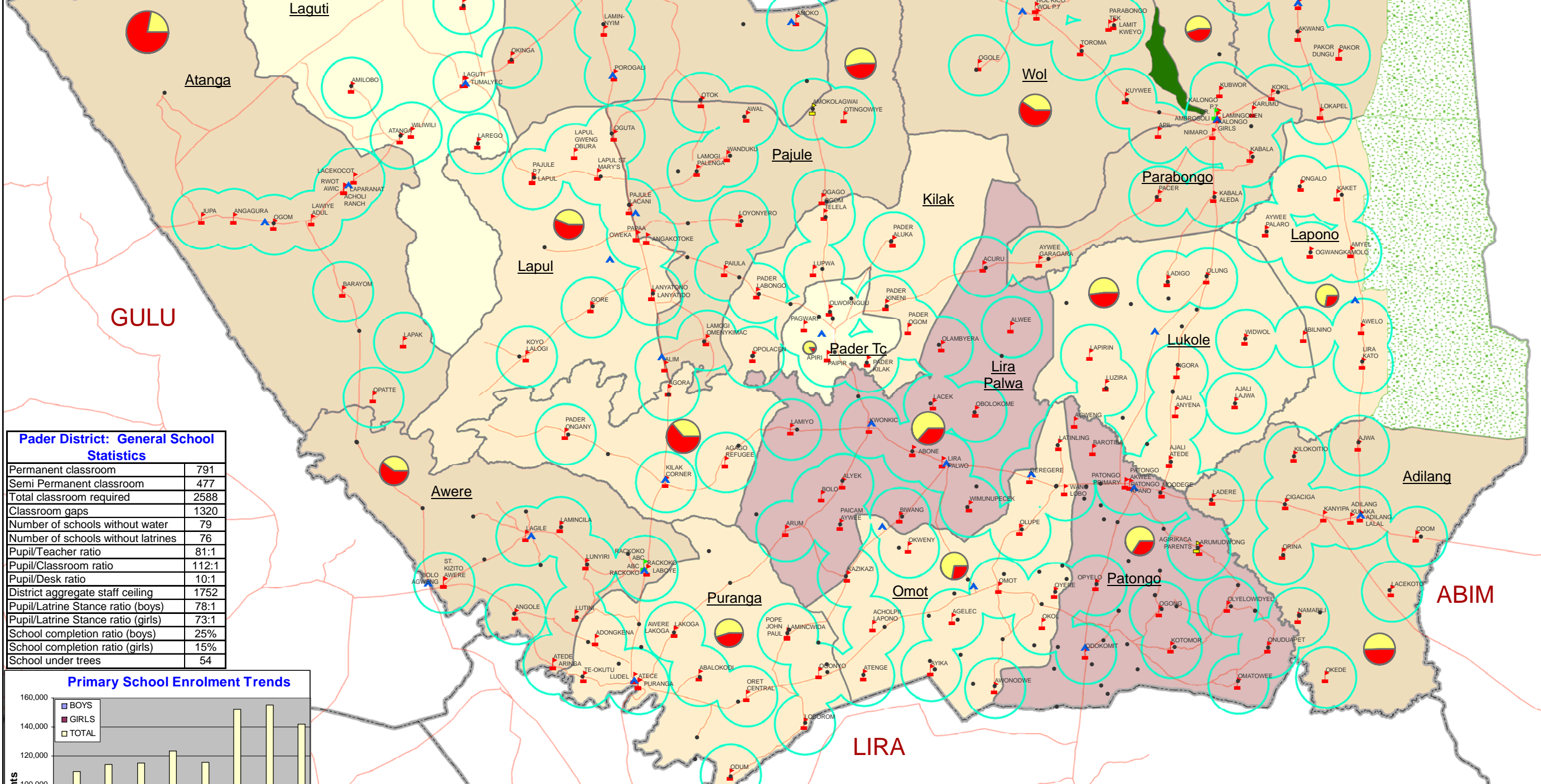

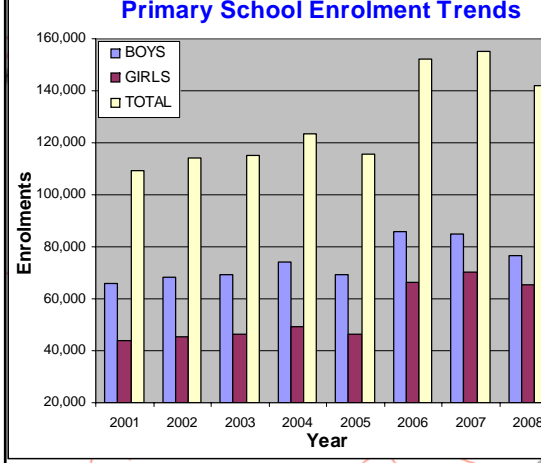
