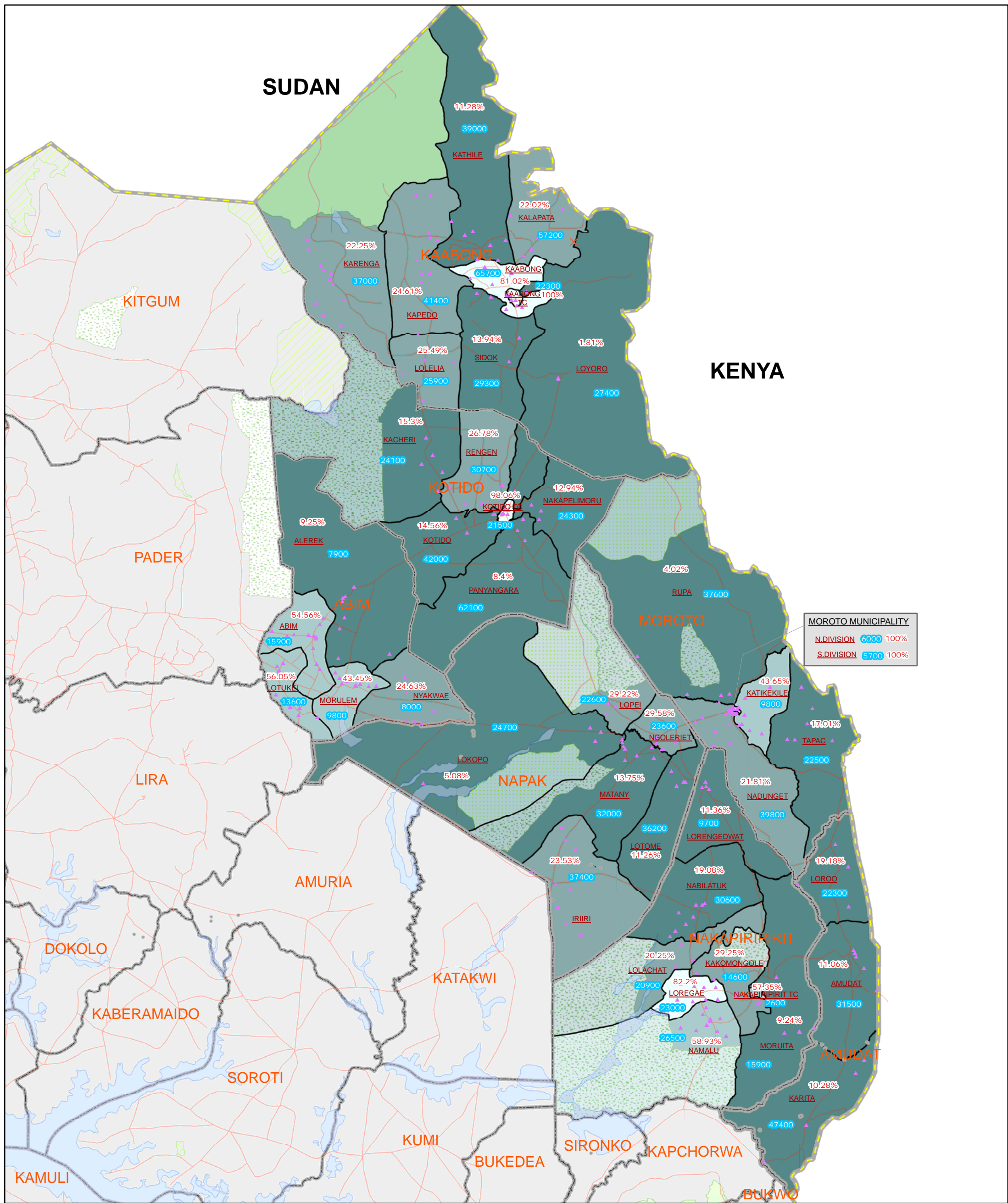
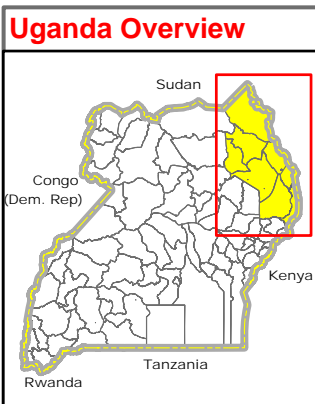


Ratio of Populated Area Covered by Education Facilities (Index Rank) in Sub-County (Aug 2010)

Remarks

Some parishes have no operation education centers within their own parish. However, they still can access facilities from nearby education centers in neighbouring parishes.

Notes:

- Ratio of populated area covered by operational Education Facilities within a sub-county is calculated by using national standards (2.5 km radius distance which is equivalent to 19.643 sq.km area using formula $A = \text{Pie} * R * R$). Approximate area falls inside 2.5km zones are treated as accessible & falls outside are treated as not accessible. Accessibility is based on aerial distance. Assumed that students travel most direct route in plain area.
- Education service coverage information presented in this map is based on available locations of operational Education Centres from the District. Please note that ratio of coverage change over time, for updated education information, please contact the respective DEO & Cluster Leads directly.
