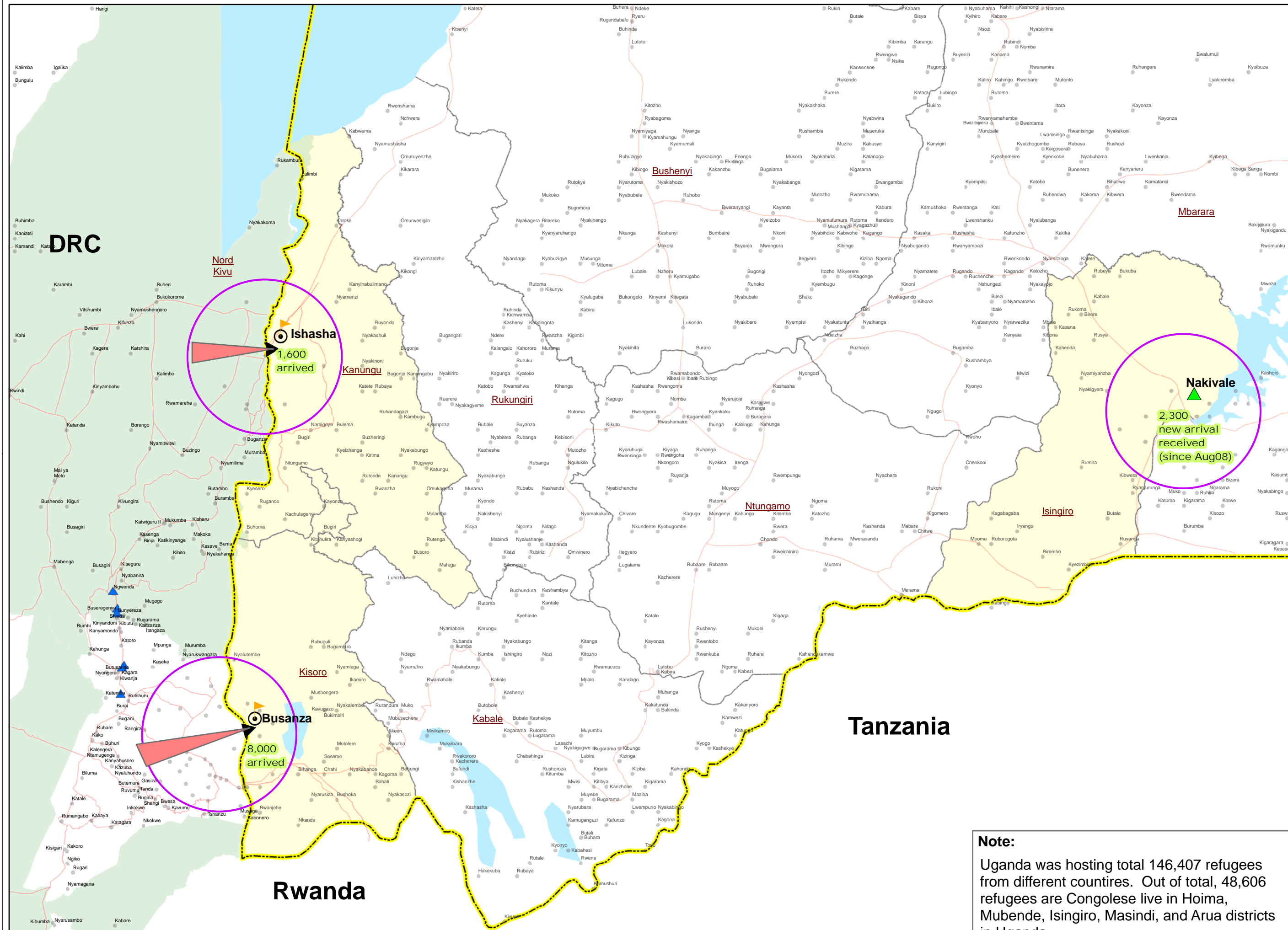


DRC and Uganda Border Area - Population Movement (Nov 2008)
