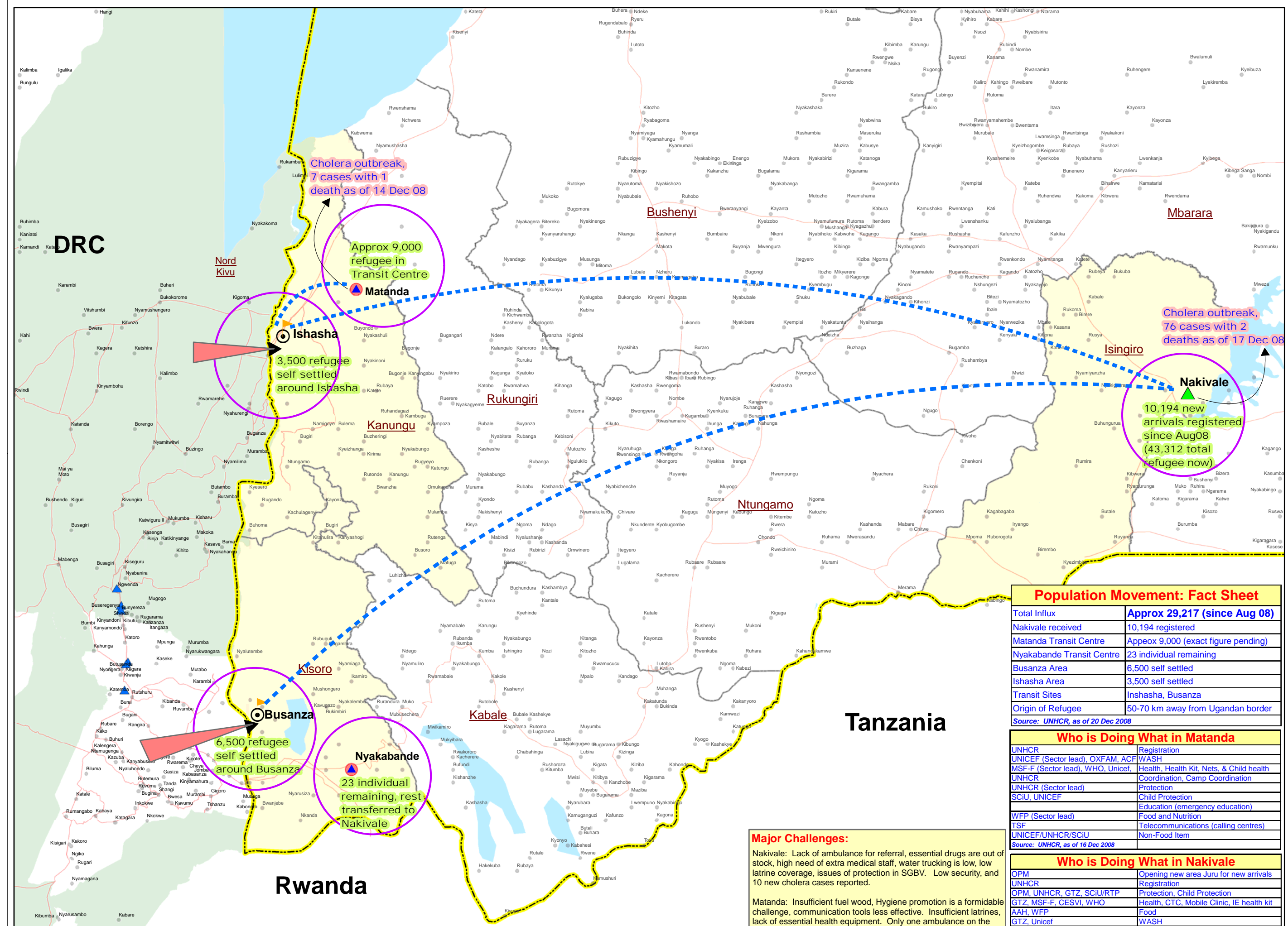


# DRC and Uganda Border Area - Population Movement (20 Dec 2008)

### Major Challenges:

**Nakivale:** Lack of ambulance for referral, essential drugs are out of stock, high need of extra medical staff, water trucking is low, low latrine coverage, issues of protection in SGBV. Low security, and 10 new cholera cases reported.

**Matanda:** Insufficient fuel wood, Hygiene promotion is a formidable challenge, communication tools less effective. Insufficient latrines, lack of essential health equipment. Only one ambulance on the ground.
