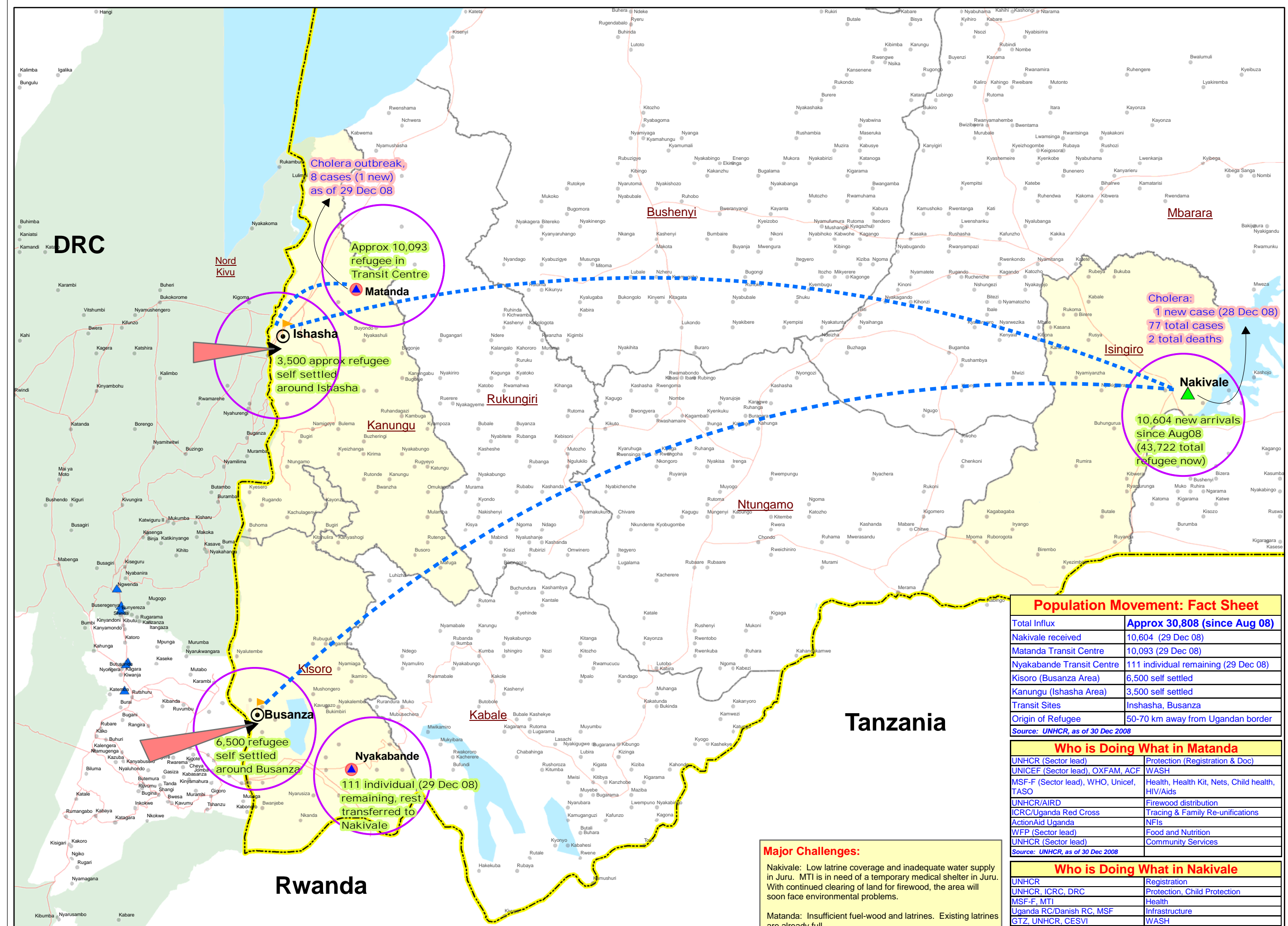


DRC and Uganda Border Area - Population Movement (30 Dec 2008)

 Nakivale: Low latrine coverage and inadequate water supply in Juru. MTI is in need of a temporary medical shelter in Juru. With continued clearing of land for firewood, the area will soon face environmental problems.
 Matanda: Insufficient fuel-wood and latrines. Existing latrines are already full.
